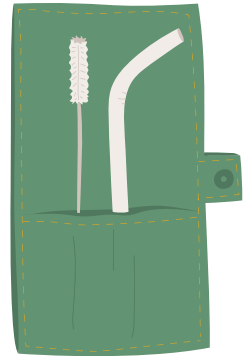


Fabrics & Microplastic - Patterns

Cutlery Roll: Base

fold down when finished

Print this page and Pocket page.
Cut fabric to entire A4 page size, extend this pattern to the right to fit more cutlery pieces if desired. Hem all edges and sew pocket onto base. Sew seams for each cutlery piece. The top folds down to keep cutlery clean. Close with press stud tabs, ribbon or fabric ties.

Cutlery Roll: Pocket

Cut out entire sections below. See instructions on Cutlery Roll: Base.

Fabric ties (if using): cut two pieces. Sew into long tube. Turn inside out (poke with pencil or safety pin). Attach to sides of Cutlery Roll as marked on Base.

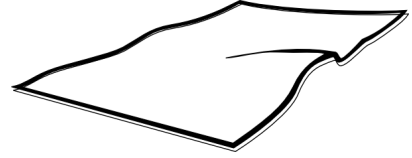

Baby Wipes/Dishcloth/ Handkerchief

Cut fabric into squares using pinking shears OR hem all around, turning in 1-2cm.

Ice Cream Cone Holder

Cut one piece from absorbent material like flannel or toweling and one from decorative material for the outside layer.



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
